This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Shamsher claiming himself to be the resident of Gurdwara Shri Singh Sabha, Ellenabad, District Sirsa seeking direction to respondents No. 2 to 6 to conduct an inquiry into the allegations unfolded in the representation dated March 16, 2015 and March 17, 2015 (Annexures P3 and P4).

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 6 only, at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. D.R. Singla, DAG, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that despite the lapse of more than four months, the concerned authorities have not taken any action on either of the representation till date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner feels satisfied in case the direction is issued to Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to enquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (Annexures P-3 and P-4).

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with direction to Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (Annexures P-3 and P-4) and in case, some substance is found, take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
