ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.30 dated 21.05.2015, registered under Sections 7, 8 and 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, Police Station State Vigilance Bureau, District Rohtak.

The petitioner is a Manager in Ganaur Co-operative Marketing Society. A complaint has been made by Peon-cum-Chowkidar. On this complaint, the petitioner along with Rajinder Malik, Retired Accountant was arrested. The investigation is over and challan has been presented.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the co-accused Rajinder had been allowed bail. He has placed on record the copy of the minutes and urged that on 27 May, 2015 a meeting has been fixed to consider the conduct of the complainant and in order to avoid an adverse order, this false complaint was made and no recovery was effected from the petitioner.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and considering the fact that the investigation is over and the trial would take time, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
