JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.85 dated 27.05.2010, registered under Sections 420, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, (for short, 'the IPC') at Police Station Moga City, District Moga.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was initially granted anticipatory bail by this Court on 19.08.2010. Thereafter, on one date, he could not appear before the

trial Court and therefore, he again approached this Court by way of filing CRM-M-29476 of 2012, which was allowed on 16.01.2013 and bail was granted to him. Thereafter, the petitioner had been regularly appearing before the trial Court. However, 02.12.2013, the petitioner could not appear and he was declared a proclaimed person on 28.08.2014. The absence of the petitioner is not deliberate or intentional as he was suffering from Hapatitis C and remained under medical treatment for a considerable period.

Heard.

From the perusal of the case file, it is amply clear that the petitioner is repeatedly misusing the concession of bail granted to him. The conduct of the petitioner disentitles him from any leniency to be shown to him. In these circumstances, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
