This order shall dispose of two petitions, CRM-M No.22825 of
2014 titled Jasvir Singh and another Vs. State of Punjab and others for
quashing of FIR NO.84 dated 11.06.2014 under Sections 326/324/323/34

IPC and CRM-M No.22906 of 2014 titled Gursaab Singh and another Vs. State of Punjab and others for quashing of cross-version recorded vide DDR No.30 dated 11.06.2014 under Sections 326/324/323/148/149 IPC in the aforesaid FIR, registered at Police Station Kot Isah Khan, District Moga.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Gursaab Singh alleging that petitioners No.1 and 2 in CRM-M No. 22825 of 2014 had attacked the complainant and caused injuries.

The DDR was recorded at the instance of Jasvir Singh regarding the cross-version.

Both the parties have entered into compromise and sought for quashing of FIR and cross-version.

Parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate and get their statements recorded. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

The parties being related to each other have amicably resolved the dispute. No useful purpose will be served by continuing the proceedings.

Following the judgment in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another RCR (Criminal) 1052**, both the petitions are allowed. The aforesaid FIR and cross-version and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to a condition that petitioners in both the petitions will deposit a sum of Rs.5,000/- each in total with the Punjab Police Welfare Fund, Sector 9, Chandigarh within a period of one month.
