DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case, FIR No.565 datd 19.11.2014 registered under Sections 354-A, 377, 498-A, 406 of IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Manesar, Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case because of filing of petition by husband of the complainant under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. He further submits that the husband, who is main accused, has surrendered before the trial Court and is behind bars since 07.01.2015.

Learned counsel also submits that no complaint was there against the petitioner for a period of four years after marriage and the question of

harassing the complainant does not arise.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and when the Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court.

The petition for granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner is dismissed.

However, keeping in view the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner, in case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and moves an application for regular bail, the trial Court is directed to decide the same, in accordance with law, within a period of one week from the date of filing of application by the petitioner for bail.
