Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 CrPC is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.45 dated 12.7.2012 under Sections 302, 307, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Haibowal, District Ludhiana.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press this petition. However, he submits that since the petitioner is facing prosecution since 12.7.2012, the trial Court be directed to expedite the trial.

Prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner carries substance.

Taking into consideration the fact that the FIR was registered on 12.7.2012 and the petitioner is in custody for the last about three years and one month, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with a direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial.
