Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.11, dated 25.01.2015 under Sections 307/34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act 1959, registered at Police Station Kot Isse Khan, District Moga.

This Court, vide order dated 16.07.2015, has granted interim bail to the petitioners, however, subject to their joining the investigation and to comply with the provisions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 16.07.2015, petitioners have joined investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Head Constable-Bhupinder Singh, also states that petitioners have joined investigation and recovery of revolver and rifle of .315 bore have been already been made from the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim relief granted to the petitioners vide order dated 16.07.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
