Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents i.e. respondents No.7 to 9.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 6, only at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Deepak Garg, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case representation dated June 25, 2015 (Annexure P-2) moved by petitioner No.1 is dealt with and dispose of within a stipulated period.
5. Accordingly, Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur to enquire into the allegations unfolded by the petitioners in

representation dated June 25, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and in case any substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
