Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.35 dated 13.04.1990, under Sections 304-A,337, 279 IPC, registered at Police Station, Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

Perusal of the order dated 04.05.2015 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Rupnagar, declining the anticipatory bail, to the petitioner would reveal that the occurrence relates back to the year 1990. The petitioner has been evading the process of law and even was declared proclaimed offender. Challan was presented in the Court in his absence.

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Conduct of the petitioner as reflected in the order dated 04.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) shows that petitioner is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition stands dismissed.
