Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner No.1 being widow feels apprehension that his minor children i.e. petitioner No.2 and 3 may not be forcibly taken by her mother-in-law and the private respondents.

Apparently, there is no grievance made by the petitioners before the police. At this stage, learned counsel seeks withdrawal of petition with liberty to approach respondents No.2 and 3 by way of moving proper complaint/ representation for redressal of claim of the petitioners.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
