JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Two petitioners claiming themselves to be major in age and have solemnized their marriage on 13.07.2015 as per Hindu rites and ceremonies at Prachin Shiv Mandir, Mansa Devi Complex, Panchkula.

Since the parents and family members of the girl i.e. respondent Nos. 4 to 8, who are residents of VPO Mandebar, Tehsil Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar, were not accepting the marriage, the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. was filed seeking protection of life and liberty by providing adequate police protection.

Upon notice, learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljit Singh, Police Station Jhansa, Kurukshetra, has put in appearance and states that as the family members of the girl have accepted the marriage and have got recorded their statements to that effect, there is no further cause or threat to be harboured by

the petitioners. Even the parents of the girl are present in the Court and have voluntarily accepted the marriage and state that threat, if any, is totally misplaced.

In view of the above, learned Counsel for the petitioners states that no further orders are required in the present case.

Hence, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
