Through the instant petition the petitioner has prayed for issuance of suitable direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to get the investigation completed in FIR No.64 dated 20.2.2015, under Sections 498-A, 406, 323 and 506 read with Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal.

Though the Court has no jurisdiction to monitor the investigation, however, considering the fact that the FIR was registered on 20.2.2015 and petitioner has submitted a representation on 25.6.2015 for the fair investigation of the case, respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Palwal, is directed to take note of the contents of the

representation dated 25.6.2015 (Annexure P-2) and to take appropriate action as warranted under the law.
