Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner-Sandeep in case FIR No.379 dated 21.09.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 386, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sadar, Sonapat and the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 07.01.2015 (Annexure P-2).

As per the allegations accused Sandeep along with his co-accused i.e. his father Mahender and 2/3 unknown persons had gone to the house of the complainant on 19.09.2014 at about 7.45 AM and were seeking to extort Rs.3 lacs and further gave beatings to him leading to the lodging of

the present FIR.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the FIR having been quashed vide separate order of even date passed in CRM-M No.2712 of 2015, present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
