There is a plea that petitioner no.1 converted to Christianity and then married petitioner no.2.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to approach respondent no.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar who would look into the allegation and take steps in accordance with law if situation so warrants.

This order shall not be construed to be conferring

legitimacy or authenticity to the factum of marriage having been performed as the Court is clearly deprived of any means to determine the facts.
