RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK J. (ORAL)

Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., have approached this Court seeking direction to the official respondents to take action against private respondents No. 4 to 8 on the complaint dated 30.6.2015, submitted by the petitioners to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent no.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that when the grievance of the petitioners was not being redressed by the respondent authorities, they finally approached the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 by way of their complaint dated 30.6.2015 (Annexure P-1), but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that the petitioners will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide their complaint, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioners, raised vide their complaint dated 30.6.2015 (Annexure P-1), and decide the same, at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
