Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner namely Bakshish Singh in case FIR No.167 dated 26.06.2015 for offence punishable under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Chandimandir, Panchkula.

As per the allegations, the atrocities of the petitioner led his neighbour Rajinder Singh to commit suicide.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an old man of 80 years and a false case has been foisted upon him due to the dispute between his sons, grandsons and the family of the deceased.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Ramesh Kumar states that petitioner has not joined investigation.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the age of the petitioner Bakshish Singh, his prayer for grant of anticipatory bail is accepted. It is ordered that in case he is arrested he shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer. However, he shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.PC.
