Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner Sanjeev Kumar in case FIR No.37 dated 01.06.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 406 and 498-A of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Women Cell, District Jalandhar.
