HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the son of the petitioners, namely, Jatinder Singh has taken loan from respondent No.4 but he has repaid the same and nothing is outstanding against the petitioners or their son but still the petitioners are being threatened by respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon the order dated 9.4.2015 passed in Criminal Misc. No. M-11514 of 2015 in case 'Jatinder Singh vs. State of Punjab and others'.

Though, apparently there seems to be money transaction between the son of the petitioners and respondent No.4, however, without

commenting upon the aforesaid transaction, respondent No.2-Police Commissioner, Amritsar is directed to look into the contents of the representation (Annexure P-2) dated 2.7.2015 and decide the same in accordance with law. However, in case the submissions made in the representation (Annexure P-2) are found motivated, necessary action may be initiated against the petitioners as well in accordance with law.
