By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.115, dated 10.02.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Yamunanagar City, District Yamunanagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is an old lady of 70 years. She never executed power of attorney in favour of Nirmala Devi, who allegedly received the entire amount from the complainant by way of pay order No.770052 dated 02.01.2002, drawn on Punjab National Bank, Jagadhri. The said transaction took place in the year 2002, whereas, the FIR is

registered on 02.02.2015. He further states that in pursuance of the order dated 24.08.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 24.08.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
