Rameshwar Singh Malik , J. (Oral)

Learned senior counsel for respondent No.2 submits that in view of the nature of controversy involved and also by afflux of time, coupled with another material fact that respondent-sugar mill has been closed down long back, no cause of action would survive and the present writ petition may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Learned senior counsel for respondent No.2 prima facie seems to be justified in making the above said statement. This seems to be the reason that neither nobody has come present to press the writ petition nor any request for pass over has been made.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, since nobody is present on behalf of the petitioner, liberty is granted to get the present petition revived, if necessity arises.
