AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.25 dated 12.05.2015 registered under Sections 326, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 30.07.2015 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
