State counsel, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

No direction is required to be issued by this Court to register FIR against respondents No. 4 to 7 as was also observed in the order passed on the last date.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that he had written to the Director General of Police, Punjab, vide representation (Annexure P-5), but after recording his statement, no further action was taken, though fraud relating to property worth Rs.50,00,00,000/- (Fifty crore) was committed as per the petitioners.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police, Punjab, to look into the matter

personally and dispose of the representation (Annexure P5) with intimation to the petitioners within two months from the date of receipt of copy of the order.
