FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.20 dated 26.4.2015 under Section 354-A IPC and Section 10 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences registered at Police Station, Abohar, District Fazilka

The allegations against the petitioner-Rajnish Kumar in this regular bail application are that on 9.4.2015 he tried to outrage the modesty of the child, aged around 12 years, daughter of the complainant Reshma Malik. It is contended on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner happens to be the Reader of the Commanding Officer of B.S.F Unit from where the husband of the complainant has been transferred out prior to this and it is on account of vengeance the present case has been filed and that there is no medico legal examination to support the

contentions which could not be controverted on behalf of the State.

In view thereof and keeping in view that the culpability, if any, shall be determined at the time of trial, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
