This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioners in a case registered against them vide FIR No.27 dated 01.04.2015 under Sections 307/324/323/148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Kathu Nangal, Tehsil and District Amritsar.

Stand of petitioners is that they were also hurt in the incident as injuries were caused by the complainant side. Petitioners are stated to be in custody for last three months.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer for bail.

As it is yet to be determined as to who was the aggressor in the incident and investigating agency has not been able to complete the investigation till now, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioners any longer. They have been already in custody for almost three months. Under the circumstances, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
