MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioners pray for grant of pay scale of Rs.7500-12000 admissible to Headmasters w.e.f 1.1.1996.

Learned State counsel states that a decision to this effect has already been taken and necessary sanction accorded. For the purposes of reference the decision as contained in the order dated 16.3.2015 is extracted herebelow:

“Therefore, Administrative Department is advised to implement the orders dated 1st December, 2010 and allow the pay scale of Rs.7500-12000 to Head Masters (High School) w.e.f

1.1.1996 notionally and actually from prospective effect. However

the arrears of pay for petitioners only are restricted to 38 months from the date of filing the writ petition. The other Head Masters will not be entitled to any arrears.”

In view of the above, I am of the opinion that since claim of the petitioners stands accepted by the respondents, instant petition needs to be disposed of with a direction that the consequential benefits as stipulated in the aforesaid decision be released to the petitioners positively within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy
