Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.152 dated 29.06.2015, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Following order was passed by this Court on 31.07.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the occurrence as stated in the First Information Report had taken place outside the house of the complainant. Also in the inquiry held by Deputy Superintendent of Police it was found that the place of occurrence was outside the house of the complainant.

Learned State counsel submits that the investigations are still in process and there is only one line in the Zimini written by the Investigation

officer that as stated by the villagers, the occurrence had taken place outside the house. He submitted that the final report has not been prepared so far and requested for time to intimate the current status of investigation.

Posted to 11.09.2015.

Meantime, petitioners will join the investigation. In case of their arrest, they shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer, subject to the following conditions:

- i) they shall make herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) they shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and*
- (iii) they shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court."*

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Bhupinder Singh has submitted that petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 31.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
