JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.86 dated 09.08.2014, under Sections 382, IPC (Sections 365 and 473 of IPC and under Section 25,54,59 of the Arms Act added later on), registered with Police Station PAU, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

As per the FIR, one Daljit Singh @ Bhola took away Fortuner Car belonging to the complainant while the petitioner/accused-Jasvir Singh, helper in the Hotel of the said Daljit Singh, is stated to be following the said Car while driving a Skoda Car.

It is submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 30.08.2014 and the main accused-Daljit Singh @ Bhola has been extended the benefit of bail by this Court, vide order dated 06.07.2015, passed in CRM-M No.39317 of 2014.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from, S.I. Karnail Singh, does not refute the aforesaid factual position.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner/accused-Jasvir Singh, this Court finds that he deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
