RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R No. 13 dated 01.03.2014, under Sections 380, 454, 497, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar Malaut, District Muktsar.

Complainant is the father-in-law of Sukhpreet Kaur-petitioner No.1. Marriage of the son of complainant was solemnized with Sukhpreet Kaur on 09.03.2004. The allegation in the FIR is that Sukhpreet Kaur had left her in-laws house in an Alto car and had taken away Rs.18,900/- in cash and gold ornaments with her.

Pursuant to the order dated 14.07.2014 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and the dispute remains regarding recovery of the Alto car and some ornaments. An affidavit of complainant Sukhmander @ Mandar was filed on 27.01.2015 to the effect that the Alto

car is not in his possession.

The number of the car is not mentioned in the FIR. Furthermore, the marriage between the parties was solemnized about 10 years back.

Since the petitioners have already joined the investigation, the order dated 14.07.2014 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
