Notice of motion.

State counsel, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

The prayer in the petition is that the respondents may be directed to expedite the investigation of case FIR No. 218 dated 18.12.2014 of Police Station Chatiwind, District Amritsar. No such direction can be issued as the registration of the case was in December, 2014.

It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that the Station House Officer Mr. Sikander Singh is related to the accused and for that reason, investigation is not being conducted. It is further submitted that representations Annexures P-2 and P-3 were made to the Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar, but no action was taken.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction

to the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar, to look into the representations (Annexures P-2 and P-3) made by the petitioner and to dispose of the same within forty-five days from the date of receipt of copy of the order.
