RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite release of petitioner from unlawful detention of private respondents in **CRWP No.854 of 2015**, he is being harassed continuously by private respondents. Even his movements have been curtailed to the extent that he could not join his duties. Respondent No.4 is claimed to be first wife of petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Luthra, A.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Let three copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of filing reply at this stage.

On the grievance of petitioner, a representation dated 24.06.2015 (Annexure P-4) is already pending before respondent No.2.

At this stage, without embarking upon merits of the claim of petitioner, it would be just and expedient to direct respondent No.2 to have fair look on the claim of petitioner and decide the representation dated 24.06.2015 (Annexure P-4) on merits after giving due opportunity of hearing to petitioner.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
