The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by Sarita seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty and also directing the police officials not to torture mentally and physically and not to interfere in her personal life.

Notice to respondents No.1 to 3, only at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. D.R. Singla, D.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Petitioner moved representation (Annexure P-5) for getting the needful done but no action has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated 15.05.2015 (Annexure P-5).

The instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Panchkula, District Panchkula to look into the grievances of petitioner unfolded by her in her representation dated 15.05.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
