Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 20.1.2015. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure P-4. Matriculation certificate showing the date of birth of petitioner No. 1 and Middle class examination certificate of petitioner No. 2 have been placed on file as Annexures P-1 and P-2. Marriage certificate has placed on file as Annexure P-3.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 20.1.2015 (Annexure P-5) before the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life and liberty from the private

respondents.

In these circumstances, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to consider the application of the petitioners dated 20.1.2015 (Annexure P-5) and assess the threat perception attributed to the life and liberty to the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be taken to be the proof of valid marriage.
