Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., is for grant of bail to petitioners Ms. Manju and Ms. Parveen, who have been booked for having committed the offences under Sections 147, 148, 302, 323 and 452 read with Section 149 IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No.248 dated 13.05.2015, registered at Police Station, Dadri, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel contends that as per prosecution version, Rajesh had since died on account of the injuries received in the incident; there were two injured, namely, Surender and Bijender; petitioner Ms.Manju had inflicted simple injury by means

of a brick bat to Bijender while petitioner Ms.Parveen had caused an injury by means of the wooden portion of the spade on the person of Surender. He further submits that as many as six persons of one family have been implicated just to widen the array of the accused. The petitioners, who are women, if granted bail would be in a position to look after the children left behind at their respective houses.

Learned counsel for the State, after taking instructions from Head Constable Radhe Shyam of Police Station Sadar Dadri, District Bhiwani and after going through the police file brought by the said Head Constable very fairly concedes that the petitioners, who are women, had caused simple injuries on the persons of Surender and Bijender. He further concedes that the petitioners are behind the bars from 21.05.2015 and after completion of the investigation, the charge-sheet (report under Section 173, Cr.P.C.) has been presented.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, going through the material available on record and the role assigned to the petitioners, the present petition is accepted. Petitioners Manju w/o Ishwar Singh and Parveen wife of Rajbir, both residents of village Loharwala, Tehsil Charkhi Dadri, District Bhiwani, who are presently confined in District Jail, Bhiwani, are directed to be released on bail, subject to their furnishing bail bonds to the

satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate,
Bhiwani.
