RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure ('Cr.P.C.' for short), seek transfer of investigation in FIR No.67 dated 10.06.2014 under Section 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga, to some independent agency.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply was filed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga, submits that a fair and effective investigation was conducted. On conclusion of the investigation, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been presented to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction. She further submits that since no

investigation is pending, present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioners also fairly states that let the present petition be disposed of, in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State but liberty may be granted to the petitioners to pursue their remedy, in accordance with law.
