Petitioner is a lady who has sought direction by filing this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect her life and liberty as the respondents No. 4 and 5 have been conducting raids in her house at the instance of respondent No.3, SHO, Police Station Chheharta, Amritsar.

The son of the petitioner is stated to be an accused in a few criminal cases. Few photographs taken from CCTV camera indicating the presence of number of police officials outside the house of the petitioner are placed on record. No report has been received whether petitioner is required in any other case or not, though, three opportunities have already been given.

In the abovesaid circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner is required to be called to the police station for any investigation, she would be entitled to be issued an advance notice of at least five days.

This direction will also be applicable in case she is required to be arrested in any case on the basis of any information received regarding commission of cognizable offence or having connived with her son.

This order will remain operative only in the circumstances mentioned in the petition and for a period of one year henceforth.
