Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the bail application of the petitioner was dismissed by learned trial Court on 02.02.2015. Sunil Kumar, son of Chander Parkash, the star witness of the prosecution, who had allegedly last seen Anil

(since deceased) in the company of the petitioner, had appeared as witness before learned trial Court on 07.02.2015 and he failed to support the prosecution case, therefore, in view of the material change in the circumstances, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition for grant of bail before learned trial Court.
