Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for directing respondent nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has moved a complaint dated 11.08.2014 (Annexure P/6) to respondent no.4 – S.H.O., Police Station Zirakpur, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali), but till date, no action has been taken thereon.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise his grievance before the competent authority including Senior

Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali). In the meantime, respondent no.4 – S.H.O., Police Station Zirakpur shall look into the grievance of the petitioner specifically made in complaint dated 11.08.2014 (Annexure P/6) and take appropriate action in accordance with law and copy of the order so passed shall be communicated to the petitioner.
