Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.168 dated 28.6.2015 under Sections 188, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC registered at Police Station Baroda, District Sonapat.

This Court vide order dated 20.7.2015 has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to his joining the investigation and complying with the provisions of Section 438(2) CrPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant

to aforesaid order dated 20.7.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gulshan Kumar, does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, however, submits that stamp is required to be recovered from the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no stamp in his possession and the alleged medical certificate is already on the record of the prosecution.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 20.7.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
