Notice of motion.

On asking of the court, Mr. Yogesh Gupta, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the court accepts notice and submits that intimation by Registry informing of fixation of the petition has already been received and record of the case is available with him.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner had identified Narpinder Singh, who stood surety for accused Arvind Kumar in case FIR No. 68 dated 25.8.2009 registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District Mohali.

As per case of prosecution, the particulars of property furnished by Narpinder Singh were found to be fake and forged. The petitioner was taken into custody on 15.4.2015. The investigation is complete and the police has presented the challan. The role of the petitioner is only of identifying the surety. Conclusion of trial will take considerably long time as such, there is no purpose of keeping the petitioner in confinement.

Keeping in view the above facts, but without expressing any opinion on merits, this petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mohali.
