TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to the respondents to transfer the investigation that has been initiated against the petitioner and pending at the Economic Offences Wing, Mohali to Sangrur.

It is the contention raised by counsel that the petitioner is suffering from serious health ailments inasmuch as he is a paralytic and is virtually blind from his left eye.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length and having perused the case paper book, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter and to accept the prayer raised on behalf of the petitioner.

The present petition is completely bereft of the necessary particulars inasmuch as even the complaint lodged by one Sham Lal on the basis of which investigation has been initiated and is currently pending before the Economic Offences Wing, Mohali has not been placed on record.

Furthermore, even the conduct of the petitioner does not inspire any confidence. Counsel would very fairly concede that till date the petitioner

has not even joined proceedings before the Economic Offences Wing, Mohali. Even the certificates appended along with the petition as regards the health condition and medical ailments that the petitioner is stated to be suffering from are all from private medical institutions/Centers. One of such certificates does not even disclose the location of such institute from where treatment has been sought.

In the totality of circumstances, no basis for interference is made out.

Petition dismissed.

It would however be open for the petitioner to pursue any other remedy that may be available to him strictly in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
