Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for transferring the investigation in case FIR No.162 dated 29.10.2014, registered at Police Station Kot Isse Khan, District Moga, under Sections 325, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, to Crime Branch or any other independent agency for free and fair investigation in the above mentioned FIR.

In pursuance of notice of motion, affidavit of respondent No.3-Station House Officer, P.S.Kot Ise Khan and reply on behalf of

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respondent Nos.4 and 5 have been filed in Court today which are taken on record.

Para Nos.2 and 3 of affidavit filed by Inspector Satwinder Singh, Station House Officer, Police Station Kot Ise Khan read as under:

“2. That respondent no.4 Kapil Muni filed a complaint to the SSP, Moga which was registered vide No.88 PC-9/15 dated 25.03.2015 whereby he has specifically averred that the petitioner and other persons named in the FIR did not inflict any injuries upon him.

3. That the above mentioned complaint was investigated by the deponent vide which it conspired that the petitioner and others who were named in the FIR by the complainant were innocent. Hence, they were declared so by the deponent after detailed investigation on 6.7.2015. The investigation conducted by the deponent was approved by Gurpreet Singh, PPS, DSP, Dharamkot on 10.7.2015.”

In view of para Nos.2 and 3 of affidavit filed by Inspector Satwinder Singh, instant petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
