Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 42 dated 08.05.2015, under Sections 341, 323, 379, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar, Kotkpura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR in question has been lodged against the petitioners due to party faction in the village.

I have considered the contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

There are serious allegations to the effect that the petitioners along with others have snatched Rs.48,000/-, mobile phone, cheque worth

Rs.2,10,000/-, identity card and driving license of the complainant. The incident took place between 8.00 p.m. to 8.30 p.m. The complainant could not approach the police station or anywhere else. It is the case that the complainant had to stay with his friend in nearby area for the reasons that further harm might not be caused to him.

Keeping in view the gravity of offence, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
