Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.40 dated 08.03.2014, under Sections 323, 325, 326, 148, 149, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar City on the basis of compromise.

The aforesaid FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No. 2 Sunill Gill @ Bony alleging that petitioner along with others attacked the complainant with screw-driver and caused several injuries to him as well as Kamal Sondhi, respondent No.3, pursuant to dispute regarding the award of lottery.

Report of investigation officer has been submitted that besides petitioner, no other accused was named, identified or involved.

Under the directions of this Court, statements of the parties have been recorded and a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily.

Since the complainant injured and the petitioner have amicably resolved the dispute, following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007 (3) R.C.R. (Criminal) 1052*, I do not find any reason not to permit the parties to compound the offence. The petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to petitioner depositing a sum of Rs.10,000/- with Punjab State Legal Services Authority Sector 22 Chandigarh and another sum of Rs. 5,000/- with Punjab Police Welfare Fund, Sector 9, Chandigarh, within a period of one month.
