RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner alleges that despite order dated 05.06.2015 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.19131 of 2015, liberty of petitioner was interfered with and he was given beatings by respondents No.3 to 5 on 20.06.2015. On this very grievance, petitioner has already moved a complaint before respondent No.2 on 22.06.2015 which is still pending consideration before him.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Varun Sharma, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. Let two copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing reply.

At this stage without adverting to anything on merits, let representation dated 22.06.2015 (Annexure P-11) moved before respondent No.2 be decided.

Accordingly, respondent No.2 is directed to look into the grievance of petitioner as contained in aforesaid representation and decide the same in accordance with law. In case, if any substance is found in the claim of petitioner, then appropriate action be taken in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
