MAHESH GROVER, J.

After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file a regular bail application before the court of competent jurisdiction.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners and noticing the prayer made before this Court, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction that in case the petitioners surrender themselves before the court of competent jurisdiction within a period of one week from today and make a prayer for regular bail, the same shall be considered

and decided by the said court in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible but no later than two days from the date of moving of such application.
