Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to official respondents No. 1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner and also directing official respondent No.3 and other police officials not to harass and humiliate the petitioner by implicating him in any false case.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3, only at this stage.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Deepak Garg, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned counsel for respondent-State of Punjab during the course of day.

4. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though petitioner has made representation (Annexure P-2) to the police authorities but despite that fact no action has been taken by the police so far. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case his representation (Annexure P-2) is dealt with and dispose of within a stipulated period.

5. Accordingly, Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, District Bathinda to enquire into the allegations unfolded by the petitioner in his representation

dated June 17, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and in case any substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
