This order will dispose of the above said two
petitions i.e. CRM-M No.23414 of 2015 filed by Ram Singh etc.
for quashing of FIR No.94 dated 31.10.2014 registered at
Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Batala under Sections
323, 324, 325, 326, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860

and CRM-M-23714 of 2015 filed by Hardev Singh etc. for quashing of cross version registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Batala vide DDR No.17 dated 02.11.2014 on the basis of compromise.

The parties were directed to appear before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Batala to get their statements recorded. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been recorded that the matter has been compromised amicably and that none of the accused person is a proclaimed offender.

Following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh & others Versus State of Punjab & others 2007 (3) RCR Criminal 1052*, both the petitions are allowed.

The aforesaid FIR as well as cross version and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
