MAHESH GROVER, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take up the remedy available to him to recall a witness as it is the case of the petitioner that due to inadvertence the cross-examination of the Investigating Officer could not be conducted. He further states that a great prejudice would be caused to the petitioner in case the Investigating Officer is not permitted to be cross-examined.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid granted.

In case the petitioner moves such application before the trial court, it shall take into consideration all the relevant facts necessary for adjudication of the matter under Section 311 Cr.P.C., in particular the prejudice to the petitioner.
