This is husband's petition for grant of pre-arrest bail.

During pendency of this petition, the parties appear to have decided to part company on payment of some lump sum alimony and return of some gold ornaments. Gold ornaments have been handed over to the complainant present in the Court today. Amrit Pal Singh petitioner, present in the Court, has undertaken to comply with the terms of settlement dated 22.09.2015 and to file divorce petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act. Complainant Jaspreet Kaur present in the Court has also stated that she would comply with the terms and conditions of the abovesaid compromise and would file petition for divorce.

In view of said circumstances, the petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the following conditions:

1. Petitioner will join investigation as and when required;

2. Petitioner will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner; and
3. Petitioner would comply with all the conditions mentioned in the settlement arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh on 22.09.2015.

It is made clear that in case of non-compliance of any of the conditions, it will be open to the complainant to approach this Court for cancellation of the bail.
