Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.82 dated 19.6.2013, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga, on the basis of compromise.

The petitioner has earlier filed a Criminal Misc. No. M-20538 of 2014 seeking anticipatory bail, which was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 27.8.2014. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that since the challan in this case has been presented and the parties have entered into compromise, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the trial Court and the trial Court is directed to consider the bail application submitted by the petitioner, on the same day.
